29% of mothers left their jobs during the pandemic

"Amazing communication and flexibility"

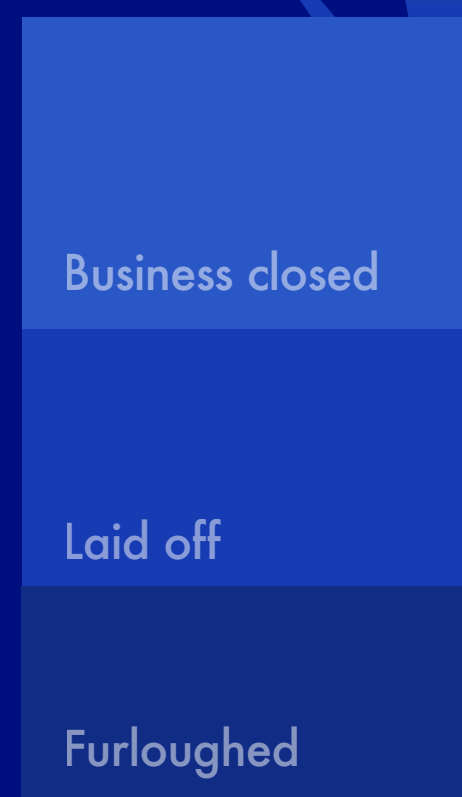
Of those who left and don't plan to go back to the work in the next 6 months:
